Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to be able to offer the Year 6s a further opportunity to have swimming lessons as being able to swim and water safety is such an important life skill. For those children already able to use a range of strokes, they will be taught to perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations. These lessons are a statutory part of the National Curriculum for physical education.

To facilitate this, we are asking for a parental contribution of **£31.50** towards the cost of the transport to take the children to Farnham Leisure Centre.

Please pay for this activity online using the SCOPAY system **by Monday 1<sup>st</sup> May 2023**. We have set up an online permission form on SCOPAY that you will need to complete before it will give you the payment option.

### Your child will need the following equipment:

- Each child will need a bag containing a towel, swimming costume/trunks every Thursday. They can bring goggles if you own them.
- If your child has long enough hair, it needs to be tied back (plaits can be ideal for swimming days).
- Earrings must be removed.

GIRLS - a one piece-swimsuit should be worn for the lessons – a bikini or a two-piece type costume is not permitted.

BOYS - swimming trunks or cycle type swimming shorts are ideal (shorts must be well above the knee). Bermuda style shorts that are below the knee are not permitted; shorts must not be baggy as these can be difficult to swim in.
