## YEAR 6 residential visit November 2022

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you will be aware, we take our Year 6 children on a residential visit each year. Next academic year we have made a provisional booking at a new centre, Hindleap Warren in East Sussex, for **Monday 28**<sup>th</sup> **November to Wednesday 30**<sup>th</sup> **November 2022.** 

Hindleap Warren is a centre that has been used by another Kite School for their Year 6 residential and it is an established company that has been working with young people for over 50 years. It is a purpose-built activity centre set in 300 acres of private woodland in Sussex. The centre offers a wide range of activities, including abseiling, kayaking, swimming, archery, challenge courses, climbing, zip wires, low and high ropes to name but a few! All activities are led by qualified and experienced outdoor education workers and are adapted to suit each visiting group.

We can guarantee that the visit will not only be one of the highlights of the year for the children, but that it also fulfils the essential OAA (Outdoor & Adventurous) part of the PE curriculum.

We would therefore like to invite you and your child to an online meeting about the visit next Monday 14<sup>th</sup> March at 5.30pm. Here we will talk through in more detail the kind of activities that the children will take part in, and information relating to the accommodation/site/meals, etc. There will be an opportunity to ask any questions and we've got a photo presentation to show you more about Hindleap Warren, which will hopefully give you a taste of what's in store.
